HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

The following is a statement of Stackright Ltd's health and safety policy in accordance with Section 2 of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, and in line with SO 45001 Occupational Health & Safety Management Systems

It is therefore, the policy of management to do all that is reasonably practicable to prevent personal injury and damage to property. Also, the organisation aims to protect everyone, including employees, suppliers, visitors and members of the public, should they come into contact with our activities, from any foreseeable hazard or danger.
